Types of guidance and where to go

1 Guidance on What to enter

- This is something you will need to gather from your department or the employee
- For policy guidance or union related guidance contact Employee Relations / Labor Relations

2 Guidance on How to enter (Happy Path)

 UC San Diego local support teams can help if you need additional guidance on deciding which transaction to use or understanding the resources.

- Guidance on How to correct (Unhappy Path)
- All the scenarios are not documented so will need guidance from UCPath Center
- Job Aid: Job Data Corrections and Retro Pay Matrix
- To escalate submit an Employee Center case and provide Ask UCPath case number





- The Help tab has a link to a self-service, repository for support materials for UCPath.








Ask UCPath

- Use the search bar to search keywords






UC San Diego

Local UCPath help site


 Transactors page has curated information important for doing transactions in UCPath

Complementary Resources


 Complementary Resources page lists all the different types of UCPath resources available

- Prompting determines how helpful TritonGPT is:
 - Make sure you are using UCPath in your prompt
 - Ask it to provide a link to the KBA
